1. Print a plain-paper test

- ☐ Select US Letter paper. Use 100% / Actual size; turn off Fit to page.
- ☐ Measure the scale: 1 inch must equal 25.4 mm. Fix scaling before proceeding.
- ☐ Measure the card outline and compare it with the dimensions you entered.
- ☐ Compare every printed entry and unit label against your original records.
- ☐ Read the smallest text comfortably at your normal viewing distance.

2. Trim and check the measured space

- ☐ Test on plain paper before using adhesive material or lamination.
- ☐ Check the entire card fits the usable flat area or visible holder window.
- ☐ For a scope cap, check the inside rim, hinge clearance and lid closure.
- ☐ Allow room for tape or the laminate seal; repeat the fit check after finishing.

3. Photograph the actual printed card

- ☐ Take a straight-on close-up with all printed text sharp and readable.
- ☐ Take a scale photo with a ruler in the same plane as the card.
- ☐ Take a wider placement photo showing the card in its intended holder.
- ☐ Use even daylight; avoid glare on clear sleeves and laminated surfaces.
- ☐ Remove personal details or use blank cards; include only what you want public.

Capture each format: stock, scope cap, arm board, wallet, match notes, range log.

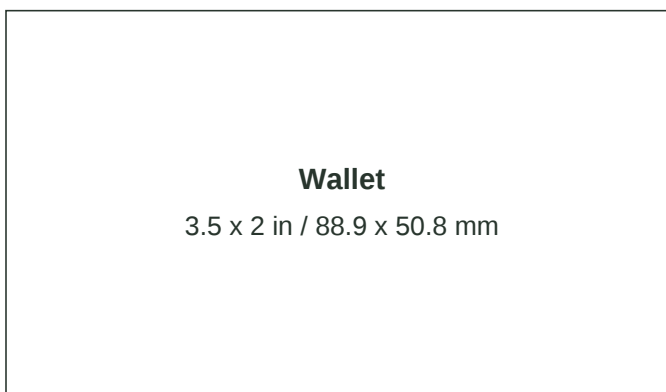
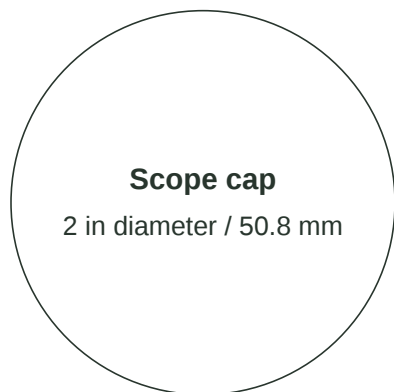
Record format, dimensions, paper and finish with each photo. Keep originals.

A successful test applies to this setup, not every printer, material or holder.

Actual-size reference outlines

These are starting template sizes, not compatibility claims or finished cards.

Screen size is not physical size. Print at 100% / Actual size on the selected paper.
